If a Student would like to bring their own computer (Notebook/ Desktop) into the College and join it to the network it must meet the following requirements:

350MHz for Faster Processor (650MHz Processor Recommended)

128MB RAM (256MB RAM Recommended)

10/100 Ethernet Card or Integrated LAN or Wireless Card

Windows XP Professional or **Windows 2000 Professional**

Office 2000 Components i.e Word 2000, Excel 2000, Powerpoint 2000

Up-to-Date Antivirus Software

Note: Windows XP Home Edition is not a true network based operating system and doesn't integrate effectively with our network.
